Marple Bridge Church Roof - I wish to inform the People of the Parish that we are experiencing problems with the Church Roof at Marple Bridge . Due to the heavy rain we had during the week, the rain was running down the inside of the roof, down the windows and also dripping heavily onto the benches and church floors. This is a problem that has been occurring over the years even though we have spent money on repair work. I believe to resolve and further expenses on an annual basis – its best to take the ‘Tiles off the roof’, put on felt ,repair any wood or window damage and restore the original tiles back. Hopefully by taking this action it will prevent -for many years- any further problems. I have a meeting with the Architect next Thursday in order to set up Tender Bills. I will keep you in touch with the costs and any further developments.
