DIOCESAN PILGRIMAGE TO LOURDES:

Please note that there will be **no** weekday Masses within the Parish next week due to our diocesan pilgrimage to Lourdes, which I will be travelling on. While in Lourdes, I will offer up Mass for the sick and housebound and people of the Parish. I will also light a candle at the grotto for all your intentions. Please note that if you google the Lourdes site, you can pick up live coverage of what's happening in Lourdes and be able to be with the diocesan pilgrimage in spirit. On Tuesday at 5pm Lourdes time (4pm yours), the diocesan pilgrimage will be passing through the grotto; and 9pm (8pm yours) will be the candlelight procession. On Wednesday, we will be at the International Mass at 9.30am (8.30am) and at the Blessed Sacrament procession and the Blessing of the Sick at 5pm (4pm). On Thursday, we will be at the candlelit Marian procession at 9pm (8pm). On Friday we will be at the grotto Mass, joined by the diocese of Down and Connor at 8.30am (7.30am) and then at the Blessed Sacrament procession and the Blessing of the Sick at 5pm (4pm).

CORNERSTONE FUNDRAISING NIGHT will take place at St. Kentigern's club, Hart Road, Fallowfield, on Saturday 15th July at 8pm till late, with music, dancing, a raffle and auctions; tickets £5 from Jackie Cecil or £6 on the door.

MARPLE BRIDGE ROOF APPEAL: Roofers came at the beginning of the week and did a temporary job to prevent any further leakage. I believe they also came last Thursday to do the survey in preparation for the tender bids to go out. Due to the cost of the project, the Parish Finance Committee, the diocese and I have decided that, although they put an overall price in for the presbytery, old school and the church, we feel that the main item to repair is the church. The architect is now preparing the tender bid for the roof, which we estimate will cost around £98,000; including V.A.T. and professional fees.

To help towards the cost of the work, we will hold a special collection in the Parish on the weekend of the 22/23rd July. All monies raised will go directly toward payment of work carried out.
