Good morning or evening to you all. Now that advent is here may I wish you all God blessings as we all make the wonderful preparation for the celebration of the birth of our lord. I'm sorry once again this year I'm not with you but I do pray and offer up my mass for each and everyone of you. I do wish you and your family all God blessings and pray also that our blessed mother may look after you especially in all your needs. You may have heard that the past week or so has been rather difficult at times for me. My blood count was very low, pic line wasn't working properly, my taste buds had gone and a number of other side effects which meant I spent most of each day last week at the hospital. However on Monday I received my CT scan, no results as yet, Tuesday I was back at hospital to get a new pic line put in and Wednesday I went to have my chemo treatment and chemo bottle. But due to my blood count still being low I was unable to receive my chemo and was told to wait to next Wednesday for my treatment instead. This gives time for my immune system to build up again. Thank you for all your thoughts, prayer's and support which gives me much strength. I'm always deeply indebted to you all for your kindness.
