FAITH IN FAMILIES has a long history, beginning in Nottingham in 1948, known as the Catholic's Children Society. Our belief in the importance of family life is as strong today as it was when we first began. Over the last 70 years we have found new loving homes for more than 3,000 children. These are children who, for various reasons, are unable to continue living with their birth families. We are increasingly reliant on donations to support our work with children and families.

There will be an Adoption information evening every first Thursday of the month 6.00pm -7.30pm at 7 Colwick Road, West Bridgeford, NG2 5FR but there are other agencies much closer to home in the Shrewsbury and Salford dioceses.

You can support them with financial donations but why not have a think about adopting and making an enquiry? I'll put a poster at the back of church and leave some leaflets informing you just how you can donate. My wife and I adopted two boys: a decision neither of us ever regretted. When they grow up and have children of their own, the pleasure continues but the problems and heartaches merely drift into the distant past. Make yourself happy.
