MONTH OF THE ROSARY: The month of October each year is dedicated to the Most Holy Rosary, primarily due to the fact that the liturgical feast of Our Lady of the Rosary is celebrated annually on October 7th. It was instituted to honour the Blessed Virgin Mary in gratitude for the protection that she gives the Church in answer to the praying of the Rosary by the faithful.

MARIAN DAY: Join us in a special day this Saturday 12th October, at New Mills church, where we will reflect and pray together in this special month of Our Lady and also join with Catholics around England and the World in celebrating the Canonisation of Blessed John Henry Newman, who will be declared a Saint the following day by Pope Francis in Rome.

Our day starts at 11 a.m. with a special mass celebrated by Fr Daniel, followed by a shared lunch at 12 noon (bring something to share, and eat!).
