Please take careful note of the times and locations above. As always, these depend on having the required stewards available. You will need to book in for all these services. Please book in for Marple Bridge Easter Sunday *or* the subsequent Monday *or* Wednesday, to give more people the chance to get to an Easter Mass. If you would like to attend more than one, perhaps call back a few days before to see whether there is space. All other services are first-come, first-served, and all are of course open to the whole parish.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS REGARDING COVID PRECAUTIONS

Even though things are going in the right direction in our country, we must still follow all regulations in our church property. In particular, we should avoid congregating around the door of the Church, and in the porches of our churches. We operate a two-metre social distancing policy. All instructions from our voluntary stewards should be followed, which are there for our protection.

I'm not aware of any major problems, but we must always guard against complacency. As the roadmap develops, there may be further instructions from the Diocese and these will be implemented as we go along. It's worth remembering that we are only able to open because our policies and procedures have been approved by the Diocese. Therefore, to remain open, this paperwork must be adhered to. If you have any queries, please ask, but do be assured that the Church's procedures will have been carefully thought out.

Please note that the Easter collection is paid into parish funds. (The same goes for any Mass intentions, donations for funerals etc.)
