GodCalls Adventure from the National Office for Vocation, is a free, 40-day self-guided course which aims to help you grow in holiness, and root each day in prayer. You will find resources on the website https://www.godcalls.co.uk/godcalls-adventure to guide you in how to plan your days putting God at the centre of your life, engage in prolonged prayer and journal your progress.

The downloadable resources focus on cultivating different virtues, ranging from meekness to purity, gratitude to courage. There is also guidance on using the Bible, and how to pray and reflect with the Rosary and the Stations of the Cross. Try the 40 days at any point of the year.
