PALM SUNDAY WALK OF WITNESS: Hayfield Christians will once again be walking though the village, and up to the top of Lantern Pike, Little Hayfield, carrying a wooden cross, which will be erected on the top of Lantern Pike, and remain there for the period of Holy Week. We will start at 2 p.m. outside St Matthews Church, and expect to have a short service at the top of Lantern Pike at 3p.m. Everyone is welcome to join, and maybe even carry the cross!

BISHOP PATRICK WRITES: "Intercare has ambitious plans for 2024. They aim to support a hospital and ten health centres in northern Malawi, four hospitals in Sierra Leone and thirty eight partner health units in Tanzania. Alongside this, their work strengthens the commitment of Christians who are able to give of their charity to sisters and brothers whom they haven't met, but who benefit so richly from this aid. During this season of Lent, when we are called upon to consider the traditional practices of prayer, fasting and almsgiving, I very much commend to you support of Intercare. Please give what you can; I have seen for myself that it will make a difference." As a Parish, this will be our Lenten charity and donations from our Parish will be sent to support it.

ABORTION DECRIMINALISATION PROPOSAL: An amendment has been put forward to the Criminal Justice Bill by pro-abortion MPs which, if successful, would decriminalise abortion. This means that it would be possible for women to induce their own abortion, using pills sent through the post, at any time and for any reason. In other words, it would be legal to abort an unborn child UP TO BIRTH, if induced by the woman herself. Such a change is not supported by public opinion. Polls suggest that 70% of women would like to see a REDUCTION in the present time limit for abortions (24 weeks) rather than removing all time limits. If passed into law, this radical amendment would increase the number of babies who are aborted. Please write now to your MP, asking them to oppose this extreme proposal. You can do this using SPUC's easy to use webtool, at www.spuc.org.uk/abortionamendments Please also pray for the defeat of this amendment, for protection of unborn babies, and help and comfort for mothers in need.
