BLESSED CARLO ACUTIS: Bishop Patrick writes: 'It is with great joy that we received the news that Blessed Carlo Acutis will be canonised. Eagerly awaited by many, this marks a significant milestone in our faith journey and serves as an inspiration for all, especially the youth.' Blessed Carlo Acutis's canonisation is a beacon of hope in our contemporary world. As a teenager who embraced modern technology to evangelise, Carlo serves as a patron for the digital age. <u>Recently, the Nottingham Diocesan Catholic Education Service opened a</u> <u>chapel in his name, a nod to his relatability to the current generation of students and young teachers.</u> His life teaches us that the internet and social media, when used wisely and ethically, can be powerful tools for spreading the Gospel and fostering community. Carlo's beatification homily described him as a "model of holiness" for today's youth, highlighting his ability to connect with young people in a unique and relevant way. His witness encourages us to seek holiness in our everyday lives, no matter our age or circumstances.
