FATHER GREG We shall welcome in September Father Greg Tobin who will be taking over from Father Emmanuel as the new Parish Priest of the Churches of St Annes Buxton, Chapel le Frith, New Mills and Marple Bridge. UPDATE ON ST MARYS CHURCH, MARPLE BRIDGE: Parishioners were delighted to hear the Bishop's letter read out by Father Emmanuel at masses last weekend. Bishop McKinney writes, "I am now very pleased to announce that becuase two priests are being loaned from the Diocese of Kumba in Cameroon I am now able to appoint an assistant priest to work alongside Father Greg. This means that it will now be possible for Mass and the sacraments to continue to be celebrated in each of the churches of Chapel, Buxton, New Mills and Marple Bridge".

On behalf of St Mary's Church, MB we are grateful to our Bishop for keeping St Mary's Church open and for mass (masses) to continue over the weekend. Also, thank you to all the parishioners for their prayers at this difficult time and a special thank you to Peter Moore (retired Solicitor) who has worked tirelessly on our behalf.
