NEWS FROM THE PARISH

FR GREG WRITES: As we go to print there is an army of people across the four Churches preparing to welcome people to Mass on Christmas eve, and Christmas day. Fr Benjamin and myself are really looking forward in hope filled anticipation to celebrating the Savious birth with you, your families and your communities. Joy is the hand of God on the shoulder of a troubled world. Use this time to bring people to Christ and the Catholic Church near you. Happy Christmas from us both!

The Fourth Sunday of Advent is a moment of quiet anticipation, just before the joy of Christmas bursts forth. The candles on the Advent wreath are nearly all lit, and the light has grown stronger week by week — a sign that Christ, the Light of the World, is near.

This Sunday's readings often focus on God's promise being fulfilled through humble and unexpected means. We see Mary's "yes" to God, Joseph's trust in the angel's message, or Elizabeth's joyful recognition of the Messiah even before His birth. These moments remind us that God's plan often unfolds in ways that defy human expectations, yet always with love at its core.

The reflection for this day invites us to:

- Embrace trust like Mary and Joseph, even when the path ahead is uncertain.
- Welcome Christ not only in the manger, but in the people and situations we encounter daily.
- **Prepare our hearts** making space for peace, forgiveness, and generosity so that Christ may truly dwell within us.

As Christmas draws near, the Fourth Sunday of Advent whispers a gentle truth: God comes to us not in grand displays of power, but in the quiet, tender gift of His presence. Our task is to be ready to receive Him with faith and joy.

As We are now in Advent part II (it started on the 17th December) each day gives us an 'O' antiphon on which to reflect. This is the foundation of the famous Advent hymn O come O come Emmanuel. The sequence for the rest of the week is: 21 December: O Oriens (O Dawn of the East) 22 December: O Rex Gentium (O King of the Nations) 23 December: O Emmanuel.
