NEWS FROM THE PARISH

FR SUNDER WRITES: Dear brothers and sisters in Christ, I am your Assistant P.P. Fr. Benjamin. Hope all is well with you. Last week, we had a wonderful celebration of the Most Body and Blood of Christ, graced by our wonderful choir and many guests filling our church with beautiful music and colours.

This week, the readings for the 11th Sunday in Ordinary Time, especially Matthew 9:36–10:8, invite us to reflect on Jesus' deep compassion for a world "troubled and abandoned, like sheep without a shepherd." Jesus responds to this human need by calling ordinary people to become missionaries of His love, sending them out to heal, to lift up the broken, and to proclaim that the Kingdom of God is near. This Gospel reminds us that the mission of Christ is not limited to yesterday or to priests or religious but is entrusted to every baptised believer. Jesus looks at our world today with the same compassion, seeing the loneliness, division, and suffering that cry out for hope. He tells us, just as He told the disciples, that "the harvest is abundant," meaning there is so much good waiting to be done. He also reminds us that the workers are few, urging us to pray for more hearts willing to serve.

As a parish community, we are blessed with many volunteers, yet we are called to be those workers who bring the Good News into our families, workplaces, and neighbourhoods. The mission Jesus gives—healing, reconciling, forgiving, and proclaiming God's love - is not optional but central to Christian identity. We are blessed and invited to share the gifts we have: mercy, forgiveness, compassion, and faith. When we all try to live this mission, we will see the change. Jesus sends us out not with fear but with the strength of the Holy Spirit. He trusts us to be His hands, His voice, and His heart for others.

This Sunday challenges us to step beyond comfort and become missionary disciples who transform the world. It calls us to witness God's love in simple daily actions that speak louder than words. May we embrace this mission with courage, joy, and generosity, becoming living messengers of God's saving love through Jesus, His Son. May God be with us.

Looking ahead, Sunday 26th July, the Memorial Feast of St Anne and St Joachim, parents of the Blessed Virgin Mary, offers us an opportunity for parish celebration. We will mark the day with a Celebration Mass, a procession around our church, and a garden party with shared food on the Presbytery Patio. Please come prepared to join in the festivities and bring something to share.

The Solemnity of The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary on 15th August will be celebrated in Marple Bridge after the 11.30am Mass on Sunday 16th August, with a procession and shared refreshments.
